Doctor's Data is a non-participating provider and does not accept assignment on any insurance plans. They offer a prompt payment fee schedule for those who choose to pay out of pocket up front. These charges are considerably less than the list prices. Pricing information is provided by our Patient Advocate.

If you do decide to have the lab submit for tests that meet medical necessity standards for your insurance, it is best to check with your insurance company to verify "non-participating laboratory" coverage. The tests will be submitted at list price and the patient will be responsible for the for the full list price payment within 60 days whether or not the insurance carrier has responded.

Medicare will only pay for tests that meet their coverage criteria. For tests not reimbursable by Medicare or having limited coverage, an Advance Beneficiary Notice (ABN) must accompany the test requisition.

For those tests that are absolutely excluded from Medicare, a Notice of Exclusion from Medicare Benefits (NEMB) has to accompany the requisition for the lab.
