Genova Diagnostics offers tests that combine standard and innovative biomarkers designed to provide a more complete understanding of specific biological systems that can help physicians diagnose and treat or prevent chronic disease. These tests include, Nutritional Deficiency testing, Hormonal Testing, Allergy Testing, Specialized Stool testing, Genetic Testing, SIBO Testing and much more.

These are out of pocket tests for those with commercial insurance including Managed Medicare plans. The tests are reasonably priced and discounted for our practice. Patients can opt to pay in full or in 4 equal installments that are billed monthly following testing.

Receipts are available for HSA and FSA accounts. If using an HSA or FSA, please don't pay directly from this account as it may be billed at a higher rate. Pay using credit card or check, then submit the receipt.

There is no pre-pay amount or balance billing for medically necessary testing with Traditional Medicare as the primary insurance, unless the testing is not covered by Medicare i.e., genetic testing.
