Precision Point Diagnostics also has **Airborne Allergy testing** that looks at your body's Ig E response to many common airborne allergens, including animal dander, trees, weeds, crops and mold. [Click here](#) for more information including instructions for the test.

The **Advanced Intestinal Barrier Assessment measures DAO, Histamine, DAO:Histamine ratio and Zonulin**. Diamine Oxidase is an enzyme that breaks down Histamine.

Histamine is a compound that affects immune response, physiological function of the digestive tract, and acts as a neurotransmitter. Zonulin plays an important role in the opening of small intestine tight junctions. LPS reactions are also measured which gives additional information about the immune system and gut barrier function. The **Advanced Adrenal Stress Testing** offered by Precision Point Diagnostics tests cortisol 4 times throughout the day and a DHEA level. This test also measures secretory IgA which affects gut immunity and anti-gliadin IgA which is used as a screening test for non-celiac gluten sensitivity. The adrenal glands are located near the kidneys and produce hormones responsible for a variety of functions in the body. Among those produced are the steroid hormones, cortisol and DHEA, which contribute to metabolism and the immune response. The production of these hormones can be altered by internal and external stressors, and this can result in a wide variety of symptoms including for example fatigue, sleep issues, low or elevated blood pressure and weight gain.

The **Comprehensive Digestive Analysis** offered by Precision Point Diagnostics is designed to test the ecology and physiology of the gut. While traditional stool cultures only look for a few pathogenic gut flora, this test evaluates hundreds of different species of flora to assess the impact on intestinal health. The Complete Stool culture includes all gut bugs, measures of gut lining to assess gut permeability, as well as measures of absorption and digestive enzymes. Precision Point Diagnostics offers two panels for measuring oxidative stress, a **Basic Oxidative Stress Test** which is a urine test and an **Advanced Oxidative Stress Test** that requires both a urine and blood sample. Both shows how much oxidative stress there is in the body and how effectively antioxidant enzymes remove it. Oxidative stress is responsible for damage to cells and is a major contributor to the aging process. Precision Point Diagnostics works with commercial insurance and Medicare. For commercial insurance, they will bill insurance when requested on the patient's behalf with acceptable insurance plans and benefits for tests that are applicable. There is a \$49 processing fee due when the test is ordered which is required per test when submitting.

In the event insurance denies the claim or applies the entire charge against the deductible, the patient is responsible for the Cash Price of each test less the Processing Fee.
